## 2020-2021 Device Protection Plan

### Deer Creek Public Schools 1:1 Instructional Initiative

#### Overview

As part of the Deer Creek Public Schools technology plan, students will be able to check out a “Device” through Deer Creek Schools. Students are not required to check out a device and may continue to use their own personal device if they have a comparable personal device. Students who choose to check out a school device can purchase an optional Protection Plan. The plan is available to allow parents/guardians the opportunity to purchase protection covering the repair or replacement costs of the technology package in the case of accidental damage. If choosing to purchase this optional protection plan, you must purchase the plan before your student takes possession of the school device.

#### OPTIONAL PROTECTION PLAN COVERAGE

**Yearly Cost: \$35/Per Device**

Additional Charges will be assessed as follows:

**First Repair: \$25 - Second Repair: \$50 - \*All Additional Repairs: Actual Repair Cost**

Address checks for payments to “Deer Creek Schools Technology” and print the student’s name in the “Memo” line. Online payments accepted electronically on the district website. The protection plan will be effective from date of purchase through June 20, of current school year.

#### Examples of Costs of Repair for School Devices without Protection Plan

Chromebook	\$250
Chromebook w/Touchscreen	\$410
iPad	\$360
Damaged Screen	\$100
Damaged Camera	\$50
Damaged Keyboard/Trackpad	\$50
Damaged Bezel	\$20
Damaged Case	\$20
Damaged Bottom or Top Cover	\$20/each

Exclusions that are not covered with the Protection Plan:

- Dishonest, fraudulent, intentional, negligent or criminal acts.
- Cosmetic damage that does not affect the functionality of the device.
- Cases or devices that have been defaced or carved into.
- Lost or stolen equipment.
- Consumables including but not limited to the charger, power cable and software.

\*Exact costs will be determined at the time of the repair, on a case-by-case basis. There may be costs not covered under warranty that may be assessed at the time of damage.

As outlined in the Technology Agreement, parents/guardians who do not participate in the Device Protection Plan are responsible for 100% of the costs of any damage. Theft or loss of device is not covered.
